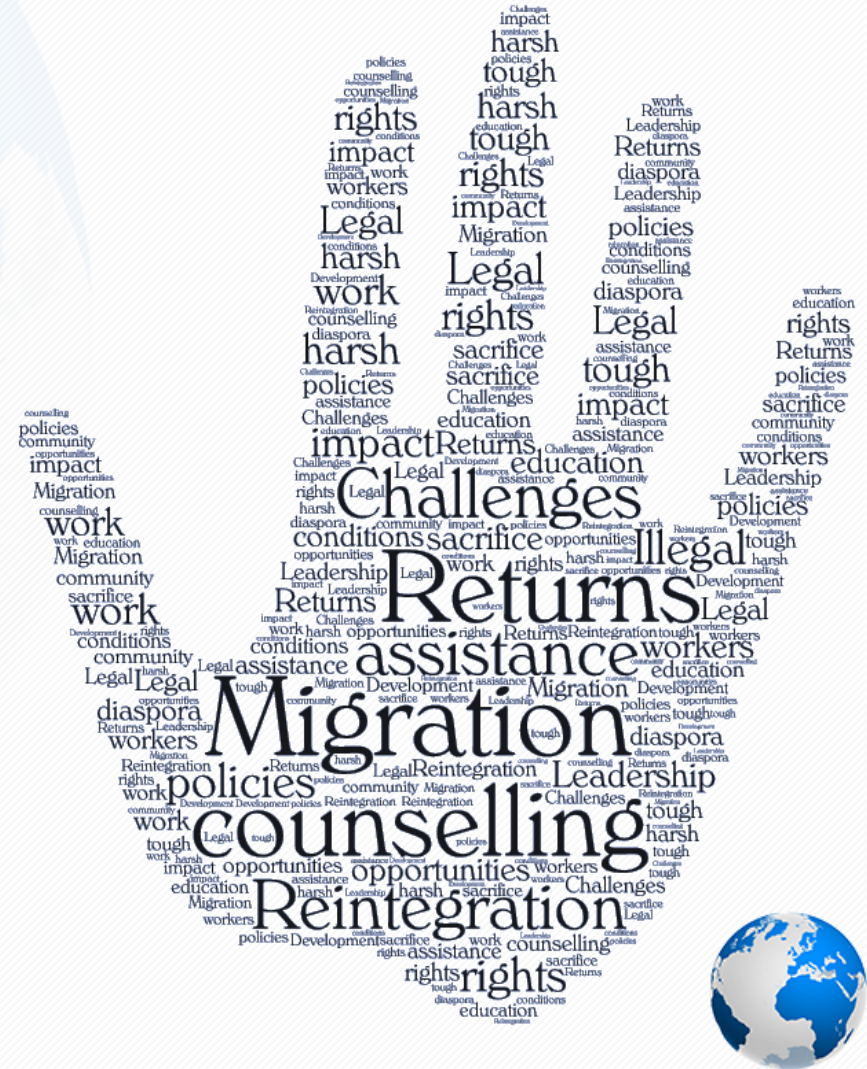

- Internally displaced persons (IDP's)

- Emigrating to ME, EU & North America

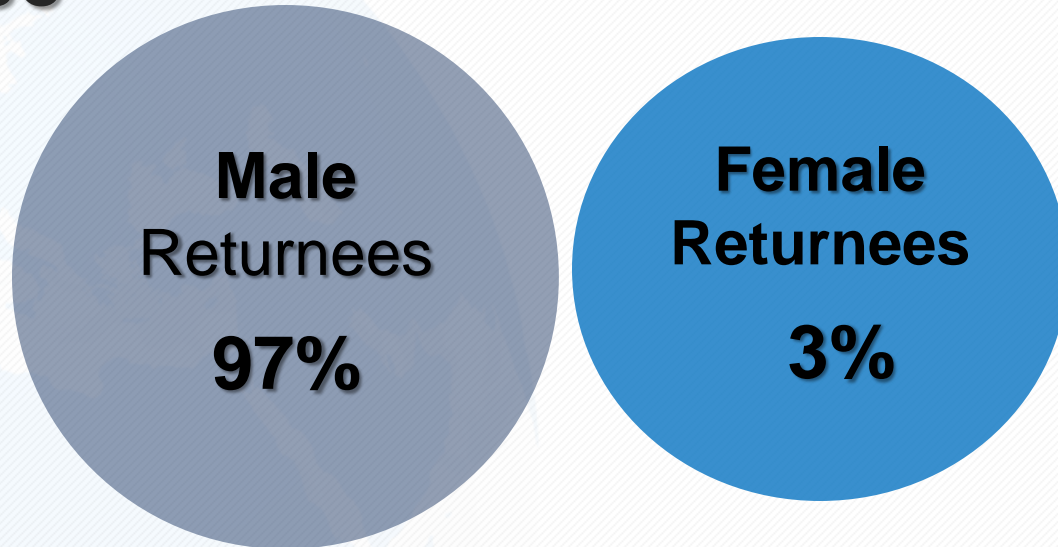

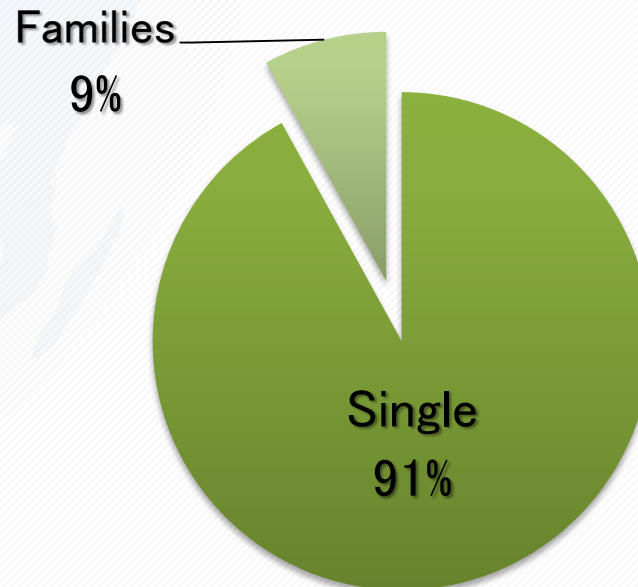

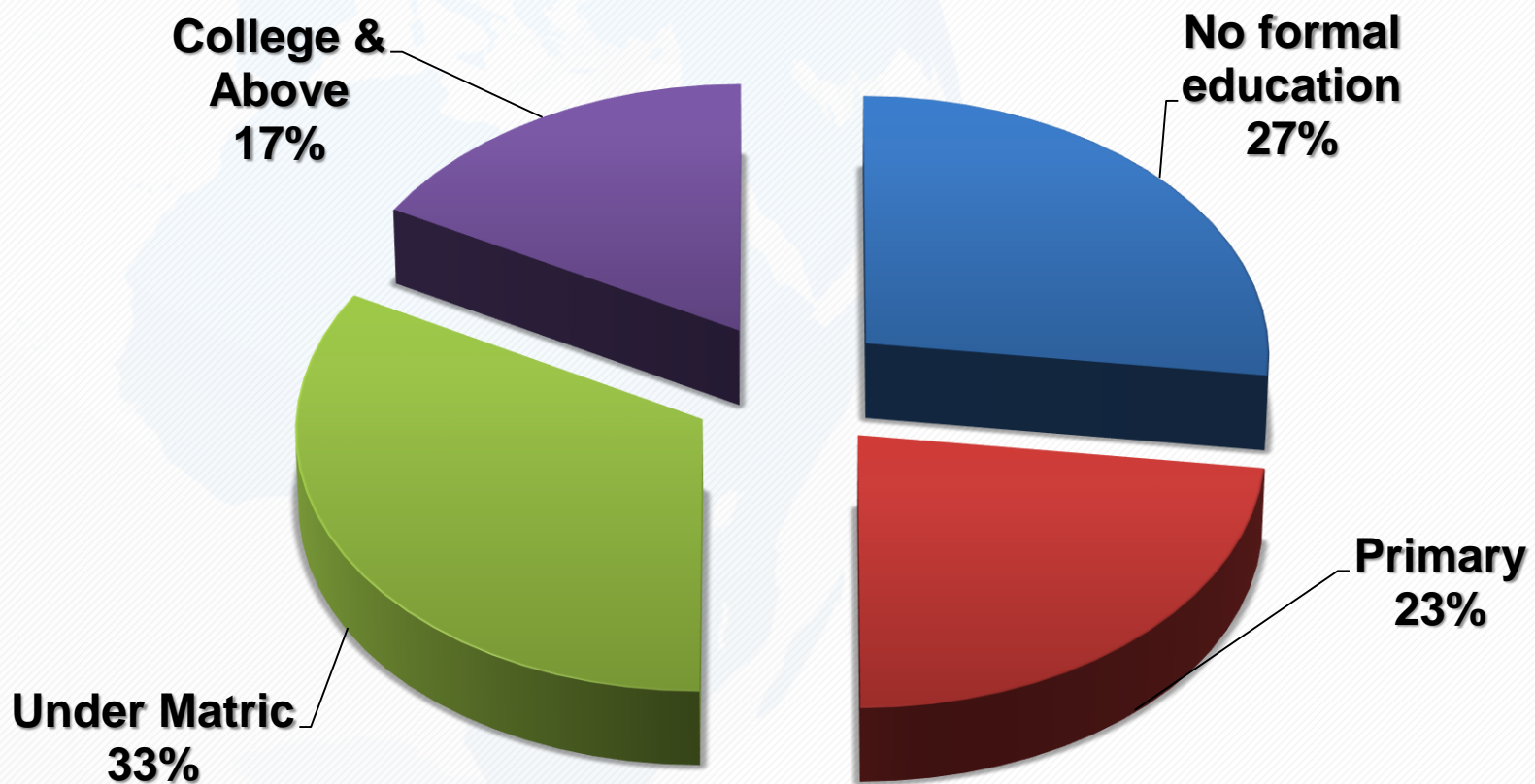

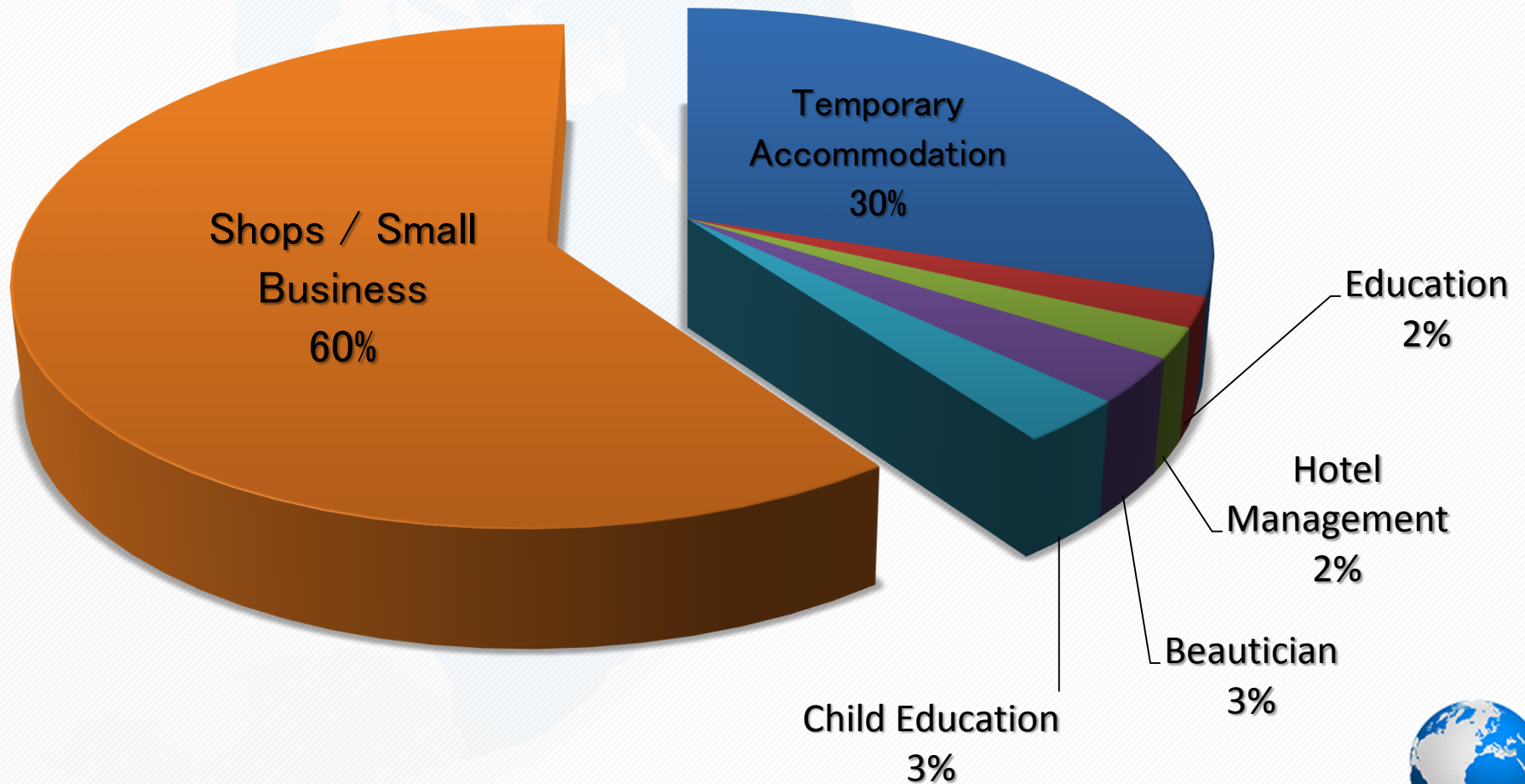
